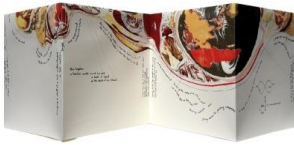

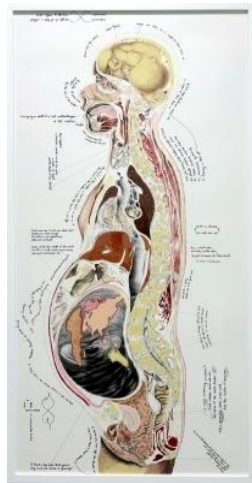
A little makes a lot of sea, 2025

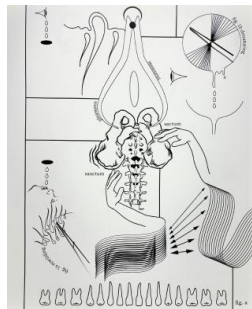
